

PARIS FONDS VERT INVESTS IN CONSTRUCÍA, THE SPANISH CONSTRUCTION GROUP THAT IS BRINGING THE CONSTRUCTION SECTOR INTO THE ERA OF CIRCULAR ECONOMY

Construcía, a Spanish construction company pioneering in the development of a circular construction model, announces that Paris Fonds Vert has taken a 22% stake in its capital as part of an investment intended to finance its ambitious development program. Paris Fonds Vert is an investment fund whose vocation is to support European, innovative and high-growing SMEs whose solutions contribute to the ecological transition of large cities. The fund, whose initiative comes from the city of Paris, is managed by Demeter Partners, a pioneer and leader in the management of funds dedicated to ecological transition. The investment which can go up to 44% of the capital will allow the company to continue its international expansion, with particular emphasis on the French market, to strengthen its capacity to invest in innovation, as well as to finance its circular real estate promotion activity.



Transforming the construction model towards the circular economy

In the EU today, construction is the sector that generates the most waste. Based on this observation, Construcía has developed its own construction methodology called "Lean2Cradle®Construcia", combining an efficient design / construction process and the use of recyclable and free of harmful substances materials. It is a regenerative model, inspired by nature, which strives to transform waste into nutrients or resources by recovering and reusing materials.

In 2020, despite the economic situation linked to the pandemic, Construcía achieved a turnover of more than €100m, an increase of + 10% compared to 2019. The company has 265 employees and offices in Madrid, Barcelona and Lisbon.

Construcía specializes in the construction and renovation of offices, data centers, points of sale, shopping centers, student residences, co-livings, hotels and in circular real estate promotion. Its services are geared towards a clientele that seeks to give greater future value to their assets, as well as healthy workspaces and conducive to employee productivity.

The study carried out by the environmental and territorial impact consultancy Carbone 4, underlines that for each m² built or renovated by Construcía, the emission of 360 kg of CO2 is avoided.

Arturo Fernández, co-founder and CEO of Construcía, comments: "We have a vocation for service and are committed to circular construction. Since our beginnings in 2002, innovation and the constant evolution of our methods have made us one of the groups that bring the most value in the sector, through cutting edge services in the field of recyclable constructions. Our growth is the result of the efforts of a whole team mobilized in favor of the circularity in the construction sector".
